## INTRODUCTION

We are glad to present the 2018 edition of the Statistical Yearbook of the Federal University of Ceará. It portrays our university in numbers and delineates the most important facts occurred on our campuses in the year of 2017.

These are times of fruitful achievements, which have been expanding our institution and strengthening its insertion in the environment where it acts even more. In teaching, research and extension, UFC has interacted with all segments of the population, and at the same time it has projected itself onto the national and international scope, thanks to the vigor of its academic work and to its degree of excellence, which increases at every new assessment process.

Some of the recently accomplished achievements are:

- Undergraduate studies have excelled in their search for quality in teaching and also in the democratization of admission procedures, as a result of the diversification of programs, interiorization and internationalization activities, increases in the number of seats and the inclusion of low-income students who stem from public schools. Evasion has decreased and the time for completion of the programs has also decreased.
- Graduate studies have reached international excellence with three programs being awarded a grade of 7 and six programs receiving a grade of 6, which made UFC the university with the highest number of programs in these categories in the North and Northeast regions of Brazil. Half of the graduate

programs at UFC have been awarded international and national excellence.

- Research has reached full maturity and seven National Institutes of Science and Technology have been approved. Also, the number of researchers with productivity fellowships in research and technological development has increased 10% in the last three years, even with the national system being frozen. We have become one of the Brazilian universities which register the highest number of patents, which is an important indicator of technological innovation.
- The Secretariat of Governance was created with the mission of implementing structures which are adequate to the University's management, especially with regard to risk management and improvement of internal controls.
- The International Affairs Office has been expanded to the Office of the Vice Provost for International Affairs. A result of the enhancement of the internationalization policy is the establishment of the Confucius Institute (China) at UFC.
- Innovation and promotion of entrepreneurship became one of the priorities under the current management. The Technology Park is being established, and it will function as a connection between companies and the University, stimulating and facilitating investments in technological innovation.
- Another accomplishment, which we attribute to the excellent level of our professors and students, as well as to the institutional commitment of our

administrative staff, was the continuous growth in the General Index for Programs (ICG), the main quality indicator of the Ministry of Education. In 2017, UFC obtained a grade of 3,75 in the continuous ICG and a grade of 4 (on a scale from 0 to 5) in the ICG according to range. Furthermore, the undergraduate programs in Design, Executive Secretariat, Public Relations and Advertising, Psychology (Fortaleza) and Business Management (Daytime) ranked among the top 10 in their area, according to the results of the National Examination of Student Performance (Enade). Among the 11 programs assessed in the last examination, six of them reached the maximum score (5). In the national scope, only 6% of all the programs that underwent the assessment have attained such a score.

• One more fact which is worth mentioning: among the 140 higher education institutions that have already been assessed on site by the Ministry of Education, the Federal University of Ceará is one of the ten which have been awarded an Institutional Grade of 5 and had a General Index for Programs between 4 and 5, which places it in the excellence range. Finally, in the Ranking Web of Universities, UFC ranked among the top 10 Brazilian universities, corroborating the results obtained in 2016. It is evident that our university has never achieved such high levels of excellence during the course of its history.

## INTRODUCTION

These are definitely times of achievements which encourage us to develop serious and continuous work and which make us move forward, despite the growing weight of circumstantial difficulties.

It is also important to point out that the year of 2017 has gained special importance due to the fact that it was the year of the elaboration of the Institutional Development Agenda for the next quinquennium. The Agenda determines the intelligent and democratic work to be done by means of participative, strategic and evaluative planning, and it also stimulates management efficiency and effectiveness. It is clear that we have not settled for just growing in quality: we intend to assure the continuity of this process, enabling the achievements that have been obtained to become a legacy.

On every page, by analyzing the data contained herein, one can secure a very clear portrait of what the Federal University of Ceará is. The Statistical Yearbook is a valuable document, available to all of those who wish to know more about the university, observe its journey and project the path that will lead us to a status of even greater prominence in the set of Brazilian universities.

I congratulate the team of the Office of the Vice Provost for Planning and Management for its technical rigor and sensitivity, conveyed in the formatting of this document. The result of their work is expressed on the next pages, by means of objective information which shapes the University's structure and comprise the main activities developed in the year of 2017. Thanks to the Statistical Yearbook, UFC is even more visible, more open and transparent.

### MISSION AND COMMITMENT

The University's mission is to qualify our students for professional excellence and to promote investigation and research, as well as to preserve and disseminate our cultural and artistic heritage. Since its establishment in 1955, UFC has upheld its commitment to serve our region, without losing sight of the universal character of its intellectual output. The

### A LEGACY

UFC was created on December 16, 1954 and established on June 25 of the following year. It has been leading scientific and extension productiveness in the state of Ceará. Our institution has 2,166 professors, 1,659 of whom hold doctoral degrees and 354 master's degrees. There are also 3,420 administrative staff members, University Hospital staff included. The university started with the colleges of Agronomy, Law, Medicine, Pharmacy and Dentistry during Professor Antônio Martins Filho's tenure. Today the institution comprises eight campuses,

three of them in Fortaleza, and five in the countryside. It is worth mentioning that our university is present in every municipality by means of the College of Distance Education.

Having a budget of R\$ 1,341.41 billion in 2017 - an amount that exceeds the main municipalities' revenue in the state of Ceará -, UFC is recognized as one of the best academic institutions in Brazil. Thus, it represents an important scientific and cultural legacy for the local citizens, contributing to the socioeconomic development of our country.

### 3 · UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

Transforming thousands of students into qualified professionals is not the sole objective of undergraduate studies at UFC. It is a greater challenge: to contribute to the generation and exchange of knowledge, helping to meet the demands of contemporary society.

Bearing this in mind, the university provides the community with 118 undergraduate programs with over twenty-five thousand students enrolled. Over seventy thousand students have graduated from our university and today they share their expertise in the state of Ceará as well as in neighboring states.

The university began offering undergraduate distance education programs in 2007, starting with 920 vacancies. In 2017, this number increased to 2,700. Undergraduate programs are available in 18 Academic Units.

## ACADEMIC UNITS

### College of Sciences - CC

The College of Sciences was created on March 2, 1973, and it comprises the colleges of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Geosciences and Biology. It comprehends the programs in Biotechnology, Biological Sciences, Computer Science, Statistics, Physics, Geography, Geology, Mathematics, Industrial Mathematics and Chemistry.

### College of Agricultural Sciences - CCA

The College of Agricultural Sciences was created

from the already established College of Agronomy, which dates from March 30, 1918.

It comprises the programs in Agronomy, Home Economics, Ecological Economics, Food Engineering, Aquaculture Engineering, Public Policy Management, and Zootechnics.

### College of Humanities - CH

The College of Humanities dates from April 30, 1969 and was established by means of a university reform out of the former College of Philosophy, Sciences and Languages and Literature. The latter, dating from 1961, was established by Decree no. 3866, from January 25, 1961 (published in the Federal Official Gazette on January, 26, 1961).

It includes the programs in Library and Information Sciences, Social Sciences, History, Portuguese and Literatures in Portuguese, English and Literatures in English, French and Literatures in French, Italian and Italian Literature, Spanish and Literatures in Spanish, German and Literatures in German, LIBRAS (Brazilian Sign Language) and Psychology.

### College of Technology - CT

The College of Technology at UFC has been disseminating scientific and technological knowledge in engineering and architecture since 1973.

It offers the programs in Architecture and Urbanism, Design, Environmental Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Engineering, Renewable Energy Engineering, Petroleum Engineering, Mechanical

Production Engineering, Telecommunications Engineering, Teleinformatics Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Metallurgical Engineering and Chemical Engineering.

### College of Law - FD

Created on February 21, 1903, by State Law no. 717, The Free Faculty of Law was the first higher education institution in Ceará.

Our former President, Professor Jesualdo Farias, has declared these 110 years of the College of Law at UFC as a milestone for both the University and for our state. Part of our institution's history and consecutive chapters of our state chronicles were written by the notable characters that attended the program for generations, studying and exercising the Science of Law. The College of Law offers the Bachelor's Degree in Law.

### College of Economics, Management, Actuarial Science and Accounting - FEAAC

FEAAC was founded by Professor Djacir Menezes in November 1938, in collaboration with Professors Lincoln Mourão Mattos, Domingos Brasileiro, José Valdo Ribeiro Ramos and Carlos Oliveira Ramos. The college began as a private institution and was federalized in 1963.

FEAAC offers degrees in Economics, Management, Actuarial Science, Accounting, Executive Secretariat and Finance.

## ACADEMIC UNITS

**College of Education - FACED**

FACED was designed to be the center of cultural propagation of our university by means of the use of Anísio Teixeira's 1930s model implemented in the Faculty of Philosophy, Sciences and Languages at USP.

FACED offers the undergraduate program in Pedagogy.

**College of Pharmacy, Dentistry and Nursing - FFOE**

The College of Pharmacy, Dentistry and Nursing was created in 1997 with the purpose of promoting the qualification of pharmacists, dentists and nurses, enabling them for practice at several levels of complexity in each of these professional fields. FFOE offers the programs in Nursing, Pharmacy and Dentistry.

**College of Medicine - FAMED**

The College of Medicine has the mission of qualifying doctors by means of appropriate methodology and suitable environment in accordance with the various levels of health care and technical, scientific and humanistic knowledge, enabling students to identify, recognize and experience health problems in the individual and in the community, and to take part in the solutions, acting with creativity, critical and scientific thinking and based on ethic

principles. The College of Medicine offers the degrees in Physiotherapy and Medicine.

**College of Marine Sciences - LABOMAR**

Labomar was created almost 53 years ago as a research unit at the institution. It was converted into a college in 2008. Now it comprises the undergraduate programs in Oceanography, Environmental Sciences and the graduate program in Tropical Marine Sciences.

Moreover, its twelve laboratories serve various departments at UFC, such as Biology, Geology, Aquaculture Engineering and Biochemistry. A national reference in marine research, Labomar deals with ecosystem preservation, coastal environmental impact, and employment and income generation in the sector of mariculture. It offers the programs in Environmental Sciences and Oceanography.

**College of Culture and Arts - ICA**

A creativity hub, ICA is responsible for equipment and programs related to the art and cultural scenario since when it was created, in 2008.

It comprises the programs in Cinema and Audiovisual, Gastronomy, Dance, Fashion Design, Philosophy, Journalism, Music, Public Relations and Advertising, and Theater.

**College of Physical Education and Sports - IEFES**

IEFES was created on December 17, 2010, as a research and learning institution dedicated to embracing and living with diversity and to offering new perspectives of opportunities and flexibility towards different learning practices, theoretical paradigms and numerous thematic possibilities, in order to keep the totalitarian policy of exclusion away.

The College of Physical Education and Sports offers the Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education and the Teaching Degree in Physical Education.

**College of Distance Education - UFC Virtual**

The UFC College of Distance Education has been breaking paradigms of traditional education and overcoming prejudice. It has also become a national model of development and provision of distance education programs.

Over two thousand students all over the state are enrolled in its nine undergraduate programs and make use of the virtual environment to learn and obtain a university degree.

It offers the programs in Public Administration and Management, Teaching Degree in Physics, Teaching Degree in Spanish, Teaching Degree in English, Teaching Degree in Portuguese, Teaching Degree in Mathematics, Chemistry, Education, Digital Systems and Media.

## ACADEMIC UNITS

### Crateús Campus

The new UFC campus in the city of Crateús was approved in 2013. It is located in the countryside of the State.

This campus offers the programs in Computer Information Systems, Computer Science, Mining Engineering, Civil Engineering and Environmental Engineering.

### Quixadá Campus

Located in the central hinterland of Ceará, the municipality of Quixadá had its campus inaugurated in 2007, and it offers the programs in Computer Science, Digital Design, Computer Engineering, Software Engineering, Computer Networks (technologist) and Computer Information Systems.

### Russas Campus

The new UFC campus in the city of Russas was approved in 2013. It is situated in Baixo Jaguaribe, generating new opportunities for students in this region.

This Campus offers the programs in Software Engineering, Production Engineering, Computer Science, Civil Engineering and Mechanical Engineering.

### Sobral Campus

The establishment of the undergraduate program in Medicine in Sobral in 2001 was the starting point for the process of bringing higher education to the northern region of the state. The campus is about to have its own headquarters, in the former building of the Ernesto Deocleciano Textile Factory, which is part of the historic heritage of the municipality.

This campus offers the degrees in Economics, Finance, Computer Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Medicine, Dentistry, Music and Psychology.

## 8 · LIBRARY SYSTEM

The archives of the University Libraries comprise almost 172,000 titles and over 725,000 items mostly available for lending. They hold collections of books, theses, journals, videos and slides.

Besides modern publications, the libraries hold rare and valuable works which date back to the 17th century. One of the highlights is Brazilian Chorography by Manuel Aires de Casal, the first book published in Brazil, which contains the first edition of Pero Vaz de Caminha's letter, the first document which portrays our country. The UFC libraries also hold original books by Rodolfo Teófilo, Clóvis Beviláqua, Farias Brito and other local intellectuals.

There are 20 university libraries.

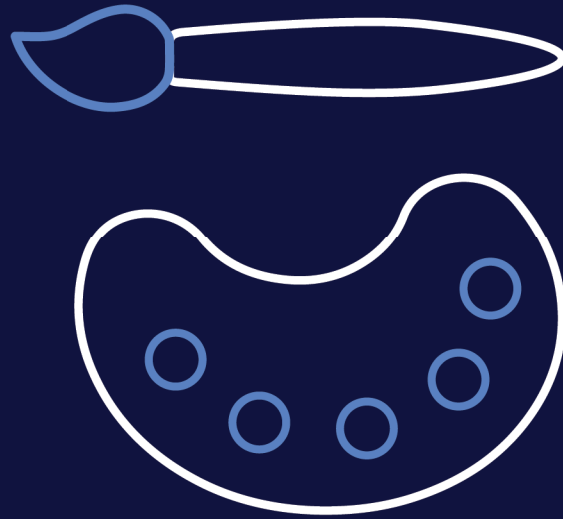

## 9 · STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Ensuring the necessary conditions for the good performance of our undergraduate students is a top priority at UFC. Thus, the university offers 1,500 academic initiation scholarships and 100 sports incentive scholarships to students in conditions of social vulnerability.

Besides financial support, UFC provides students with about 10,344 meals daily delivered at the University Restaurants (RU) and with 434 vacancies at the 11 University Residence units.

The e-inclusion program, the Psychopedagogical Support and the Medical and Dental Division are also services offered to students.

## 10 • CULTURAL CENTERS

### 10.1 CASA JOSÉ DE ALENCAR (JOSÉ DE ALENCAR HOUSE)

Casa José de Alencar is the birthplace of the most famous writer from Ceará and a heritage listed by IPHAN (National Institute of Historic and Artistic Heritage). It preserves and promotes the novelist's work, maintaining it available for public visitation.

Casa José de Alencar is located in Alagadiço Novo, a farm where the Floriano Teixeira Pinacotheca, Braga Monteiro Library, Artur Ramos Museum, Luísa Ramos Collection, Iracema Room and Martins Filho Training Center are also located, as well as the ruins of the first steam sugar cane mill of the state.

### 10.2 SEARA DA CIÊNCIA (SCIENCE FIELD)

Seara da Ciência has experiments, games and curiosities, where learning and having fun go hand in hand. Knowledge in the fields of Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry and Biology are shared in a practical and pleasant way by means of equipment created by UFC students and professors.

### 10.3 CASAS DE CULTURA ESTRANGEIRA (HOUSES OF FOREIGN CULTURE)

Located on the Benfica campus, the Houses of Foreign Culture offer courses of German, French, Italian, Spanish, English and Portuguese — all of them available to the community. The 3,855 students enrolled have the opportunity not only to learn the language itself, but also to learn aspects of the culture from the countries

where the language studied is spoken by means of entertaining activities including literature, music and other forms of artistic expression.

### 10.4 CASA AMARELA EUSÉLIO OLIVEIRA (EUSÉLIO OLIVEIRA YELLOW HOUSE)

Casa Amarela is located on the Benfica Campus. It offers courses of cinema, photography and animation, enabling the community's access to its video collection composed of 3,500 titles. It also promotes film sessions at the Cine Benjamin Abraão Theater with a capacity of 146 people. One of its main contributions to Brazilian culture is Cine Ceará, a film festival comprising approximately 600 professional and amateur films from various countries annually.

### 10.5 MUSEU DE ARTE DA UFC (UFC ART MUSEUM) — MAUC

In addition to an auditorium and five exhibition rooms, MAUC holds the largest collection of Brazilian xylographed cordel literature, in addition to works by Raimundo Cela, Chico da Silva, Aldemir Martins, Jean-Pierre Chabloz, Descartes Gadelha, Antônio Bandeira, among others. MAUC was bestowed a grant for museum modernization by IPHAN in 2008, which resulted in a new exhibition room exclusive to popular culture works. It is located on the Benfica campus and it is open for public attendance. Its main purpose is to arouse society's interest in arts and to promote artistic output.

### 10.6 RÁDIO UNIVERSITÁRIA FM (UNIVERSITY RADIO STATION)

Rádio Universitária is recognized as one of the most popular stations among the best-educated listeners and it stands out by its news coverage and musical programming dedicated to classical and popular styles, besides commercial programs. The station collection with 3,600 CDs and 13,033 LPs has become a reference for researchers with Brazilian and foreign rarities. There are also 4,800 reel tapes with programs and interviews with Brazilian personalities.

### 10.7 TEATRO PASCHOAL CARLOS MAGNO (PASCHOAL CARLOS MAGNO THEATER)

Teatro Universitário Paschoal Carlos Magno offers courses of Theater, Dance and Cinema & Audio-visual. Besides promoting studies and research in the area, the theater has been used by artistic groups from other areas at UFC as an academic discussion space and as a symposium spot.

### 10.8 SECRETARIA DE CULTURA ARTÍSTICA (SECRETARIAT OF ARTISTIC CULTURE) — SECULT — UFC

SECULT was created by CONSUNI (Academic Council) on March 1st, 2012, and officially established on April 16th of the same year. It is an outcome of a commission made up of professors who worked to “design a project to establish policies, directives, goals and management

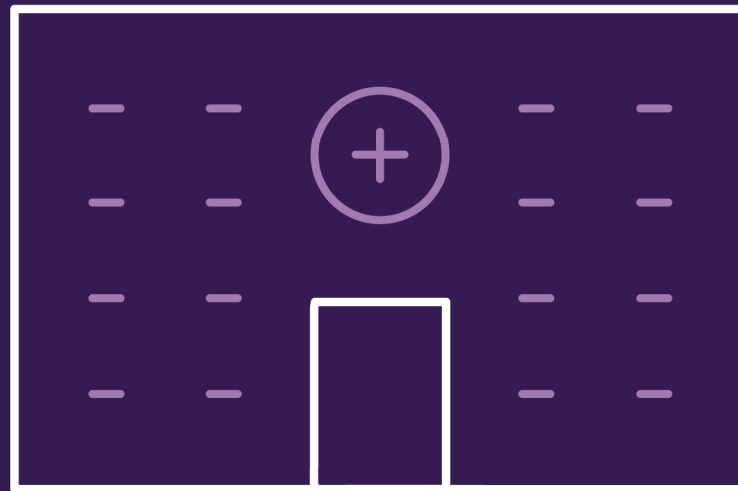

of artistic and cultural activities at UFC” (Decree 4099, October 31, 2011) by the former President’s request, Professor Jesualdo Pereira Farias.

Its main goal is to articulate initiatives related to arts at UFC, promoting and supporting actions and projects.

Its mission is to consolidate artistic culture as an inalienable dimension of academic life, searching for strategies to increase aesthetic production in the various expressions of arts, thus fostering critical thinking.



# 11 UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS

## 11 • UNIVERSITY HOSPITALS

### 11.1 WALTER CANTÍDIO UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL (HUWC)

Both urban and rural low-income families benefit the most from HUWC, which provides 197 hospital beds, over 251,000 medical consultations and hospitalizes about six thousand patients per year. It is located on the Porangabuçu Campus, also offering clinical analyses, ultrasound scanning, computer tomography, examinations both by graphic methods and endoscopy. All of them are free of charge.

Moreover, about 7,000 surgical procedures, 9,000 chemotherapy sessions and 12,000 hemodialysis sessions are performed each year. HUWC performs corneal, bone marrow, kidney, liver and pancreas transplants, and from May 1st, 2002, HUWC performed a thousand liver transplants and has become the main public center of transplants in Brazil and in Latin America.

### 11.2 ASSIS CHATEAUBRIAND MATERNITY CLINIC & SCHOOL (MEAC)

MEAC holds 165 hospital beds, performs over 80,000 consultations and about 5,000 deliveries every year, in addition to thousands of emergency services and hospital stays. Over 2,000 mothers donate breast milk for the Human Milk Bank, enabling 1,000 babies whose mothers cannot breastfeed to thrive.

The Civil Register Sector was inaugurated in November 2008. It provides the free-of-charge issuance of birth certificates.

### 11.3 UNIVERSITY PHARMACY

The University Pharmacy, in addition to offering low-cost drugs, also holds the Prevention of Drug Misuse Group and the Clinical and Toxicology Analysis Laboratory.

### 11.4 UNIVERSITY DENTAL CLINIC

The University Dental Clinic offers 24-hour emergency services, oral and maxillofacial surgery, radiology and dental prostheses.



# 12 OTHER SERVICES

## 12 · OTHER SERVICES

### 12.1 PUBLISHING HOUSE AND UNIVERSITY PRESS

UFC Editions publishes the university's intellectual output with an average of 52 books annually published, all of them relevant to the culture of Ceará.

UFC Press annually produces approximately 18,500 pages of books, journals and certificates.

### 12.2 EXAMINATIONS OFFICE — CCV

CCV is located on the Pici campus. It manages and holds a number of exams, with special emphasis on the admission exams to the Houses of Foreign Culture.

### 12.3 INTERNAL AUDITING AND OMBUDSMANSHIP

Internal Auditing and the Ombudsmanship are located on the Benfica campus and they reinforce the transparency policy and participative management at UFC. Whereas the Ombudsmanship hears and addresses criticisms and suggestions related to university activities with a view to improving its services, the Internal Auditing conducts systematic analyses of the university's activities, verifying if they were accomplished according to the planning and if they were implemented with efficacy.



# 13 INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

## 13 • INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

The Office of the Vice Provost for International Affairs (PROINTER) is the administrative unit responsible for the articulation, implementation and supervision of internationalization policies and activities at the Federal University of Ceará (UFC). These actions aim at the academic, scientific and technology innovation excellence of the university by means of the following initiatives: the establishment of exchange programs and agreements with foreign higher education and research institutions, accomplished by the Coordination Office of Exchange and International Agreements; the development of a multilingual linguistic policy at the institution, established by the Coordination Office of Linguistic Internationalization; and the promotion of international academic mobility for professors, researchers, undergraduate and graduate students and administrative staff, accomplished by the Coordination Office of Academic Mobility. Mobility is provided not only for Brazilians who apply for a period of studies at foreign universities, but also for foreigners who intend to accomplish their studies at UFC.

The office is responsible for the elaboration and implementation of 123 cooperation agreements with 95 institutions, including universities, institutes and companies in 22 countries: Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Cape Verde, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, France, Germany, Italy, Morocco, Mexico, Peru, Portugal, Slovakia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, the Netherlands, the United States and United Kingdom. These agreements comprise activities in the scope of teaching, research and extension.

Among the exchange programs coordinated

by PROINTER, it is important to highlight the ones promoted by Santander Universidades, which normally award grants to the students who are selected, and also academic mobility, by means of which students can accomplish a period of studies from six months to a year at a foreign higher education institution, but without receiving a grant. There are also other programs, such as ELAP, INSA and PAEC, which are not coordinated by PROINTER, but the office carries out the registration and the sending of the students' application documents.

Two programs in particular are coordinated by PROINTER, by means of which students do not accomplish academic mobility but are regular students at an undergraduate or a graduate program at UFC instead: The Exchange Program for Undergraduate Students (PEC-G) and the Exchange Program for Graduate Students (PEC-PG).

PEC-G and PEC-PG were developed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education and offer opportunities of higher education in public and private universities to citizens from developing countries which maintain educational and cultural agreements with Brazil. The program started in 1974 and, nowadays, UFC hosts 97 PEC-G/PEC-PG students from 20 countries: Angola, Benin, Bolivia, Cape Verde, Colombia, Cuba, Democratic Republic of the Congo, East Timor, Ecuador, Gabon, Ghana, Guinea-Bissau, Haiti, Honduras, Ivory Coast, Jamaica, Peru, São Tomé and Príncipe, Senegal and Togo.

PROINTER has also accomplished the necessary procedures for the establishment of an agreement with the Confucius Institute, an agency

associated with the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China and created in 2004 in order to promote the internationalization of Chinese language and culture. The institute has 500 units established worldwide and, in Brazil, it is hosted in 10 higher education institutions. At UFC, the Confucius Institute has the partnership of Nankai University, a public institution located in the city of Tianjin, in the proximities of Beijing, and, at the present moment, it has three Chinese teachers, one director, one vice-director and one executive secretary. In the first semester of 2018, the institute has started its first Chinese course, which has been well accepted by the academic and the external community, requiring new groups for the second semester of 2018.
